What is MOL or Mode of Learning?

MOL stands for **Modes of Learning**, which refers to the different ways or strategies students can receive instruction, especially during times when traditional face-to-face teaching is not possible, like during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Types of Modalities

Modular Distance Learning (MDL - Print)

 The most popular choice, used by 75% of students. This method involves using printed learning modules, making it accessible to those without internet or gadgets.

Blended Learning

 A mix of online learning, printed modules, and other resources. About 14.5% of students used this flexible approach.

Online Distance Learning (ODL)

 Around 7.6% of students accessed their lessons fully online, ideal for those with stable internet access.

What Mode of Learning (MOL) does Westhill use?

At Westhill, we use a **Hybrid Mode of Learning**, which includes both **face-to-face classes** and **synchronous online sessions** via **Zoom**.

In adherence with **DepED Memo 046 s2024** and **EO 029A-S-2024** of the City of Dasmariñas, in the event of a government-issued announcement for long-distance learning, Westhill will immediately **transition to Zoom classes** as scheduled.

Additionally, the school will strictly follow the **signal number cancellation of classes** and any **official announcements** regarding the suspension of classes for all levels—whether online or face-to-face.
